Introduction

The idea for the Crow Tarot began its life as a private creative project after I received a tarot deck as a birthday present in August 2017. For months leading up to my birthday, I faced a reality that left me at times paralyzed by fear, at times in denial, and for a good deal of time angry at how cruel life could be. I was a full-time artist and mother of a little girl who depended on me, and with little in the way of income coming in, I was facing a potentially devastating financial situation.

For years, I knew the 78 cards of the tarot housed wisdom and guidance, I just didn't realize at that time how to extract the information. As thoughtful as the gift and as beautiful as the deck was, what I actually received was much bigger than a tool for sorting out my problems — it was a much-needed spark of inspiration.

Although, today, the Crow Tarot is sold throughout the world, when I set out to create the deck, it was initially for my own personal use as a means to learn tarot with the help of a creature with whom I feel a profound trusted connection. For years, crows have been my muse and have played an essential role in my artwork. Because of this, I knew they would serve as the perfect energy to channel guidance.

When it became clear that other people were interested in my work and the Crow Tarot, it rekindled my passion as an artist and a creator. I felt hope again! Having the enthusiasm of the Page of Wands combined with the naivety of The Fool, the Crow started to fly.

As a result of creating the Crow Tarot, what I thought I knew about my beliefs, what made me tick, and what I eventually uncovered turned out to be two very contradictory things. What I had known of myself in the past was only the surface level junk, the obvious stuff. Creating the Crow Tarot forced me to face my shadows and the deeply planted beliefs that created the habits and patterns that lead periods of stagnation in my life.

The tarot isn't going to predict whether or not your partner is going to cheat on you or whether or not you will lose your job.

However, it is going to reveal to you—if you let it—the patterns in your life that lead you to create the energy that attracts negative situations that seem to repeat.

The question is: Will you listen?

In the end, the Crow Tarot proved to be nothing short of a miracle, a divinely guided miracle. The 78 cards of the Crow Tarot came together out of love and a determination to learn. A commitment to growing. The several-month-long creation process revealed quite a bit about what made me tick and where the shadows of the past dimmed my inner light. By the time I finished the deck, I had discovered how to appreciate the lesson of each card and allow the energy surface without fear. One of the greatest gifts the Tarot can offer you is an accurate and complete picture of your self, your strengths, or weaknesses, the inner-gremlins that wreak havoc just as things are going well.

The Symbolism of the Crow

Crows have a wide variety of reputations from divine to wicked. Some cultures consider the crow bad luck and a harbinger of death, whereas others see them as good omens. I am guessing if you possess the Crow Tarot, your opinion of the bird is mostly positive. I have encountered people who are very firm in their belief that crows are evil and represent negative otherworldly influences. (And oh boy, do I get a few strange posts occasionally on my Facebook page regarding this.) Then there are others who appreciate the magical quality and view the bird as a welcomed messenger from the other side. Unlike say the hummingbird, a creature most everyone agrees upon as being a positive symbol, I find when it comes to crows, most people have some pretty strong opinions—I find this to be fascinating.

Aside from good or bad luck, messages from the divine or the Devil, the crow can symbolize new beginnings, being crafty, justice, karma, having a strong intuition, and more depending on the individual. The crow for me represents a connection to nature, to something greater than ourselves. It also serves as a reminder that there is so much more out there than we know or could ever comprehend.

I am reminded of a Buddhist story that goes something like this: One day a wild horse wandered on the land of a poor farmer. All the villagers gathered around and proclaimed, "Oh, how lucky!" The farmer tied up the horse and said, "maybe." The next day the farmer's eldest son attempted to ride the horse to see if it would be useful for the farm. The son fell off and broke his leg. The villagers once again appeared and proclaimed. "Bad luck!" The farmer picked up his son off the ground and said, "maybe." The following day the army arrive looking for all young men as the country was going to war; however, because the eldest son had a broken leg, he could not go. Once again, those nosy villagers appeared, this time proclaiming, "good luck!" and once again, the farmer replied, "maybe."

Like the story above, people's opinions about crows have little to do with the bird itself and to do with their personal perception. The same can be said for the Tarot as well!

Our gremlins reside in that space where our perceptions interfere with our goals. My hope is that this guidebook and the Crow Tarot will help you understand your perceptions and the beliefs that impact how you react to a situation.



Connecting With Your Crows

Your crows arrive ready to talk! They can be eager- if not over, at times, communicators. You are working with wild creatures; because of this, to get the most out of each interaction, trust needs to be established. When you sit down with the Crow Tarot, think of it like meeting with a committed advisor or an honest friend who has your back and wants nothing but the best for you—but will still tell you like it is. When you approach your reading as if it was a meeting, one where time is respected, valued, and appreciated, you will get far more out of the experience.

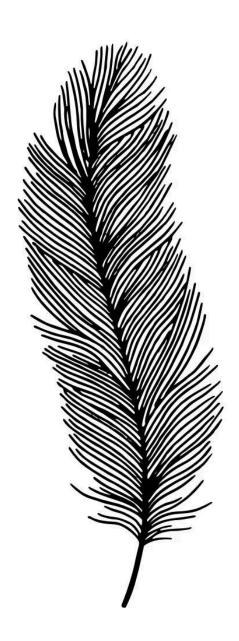
The crows in the Crow Tarot are incredibly clever birds—they know when you are serious and when you are merely using them for validation. Ardent problem solvers and task-oriented, crows relentlessly peck away at a challenge until they are satisfied. This makes them the perfect liaison for carrying messages between the spiritual and material realms. If a warning or signal is ignored, you will quickly discover that they have a talent for being persistent.

Your Crow Tarot will hold you accountable for receiving messages. If you are not picking up the messages or are blatantly ignoring them, the cards will often repeat. Sure, you can try shuffling for twenty minutes, spreading them out all over the floor in an attempt to mix them up. You can burn sage, cover them with crystals on the full moon—all in the hopes of getting a different outcome, but you will discover the crows mean business and will pick at you until you acknowledge them.

Calibrating your deck will help you establish rules and agreements in regards to what each card represents to you. Remember, the crows in your deck are yours and yours alone. They will speak to you in a language that you both agree upon. The goal is to teach your crows how to pick up and read your specific energy.

Before you start working with the deck, hold each card, and think about the emotions that surface. To reinforce or set the energy, you may find it helpful to jot down keywords or phrases that come to mind when holding the card. The more you work with the deck, you will teach your crows how to better communicate with you. Over time the relationship you build with your crows will become reliable, honest, and intimate.

To help with this exercise, you will find space to write down your specific keywords in the appendix section of this book. Please keep in mind, in this deck, and in life, crows remember how you treat them; when kindness and respect are offered, they return the favor and deliver treasures.



Preparing Your Deck

I don't know about you, but when I get a new deck, I am so excited that I just want to jump in and start using them right away. Like a child on Christmas morning, I rip open the deck and sift through the images one by one with delight looking for little hidden images or small details. I look at each card up close and then from a distance to get a feel for its unique energy. Each card holds power and tells a story, and it is in this initial meeting that I connect with all the personalities and their quirks that reside within the deck. Some of the cards create a warm, comforting feeling like that of a good friend, others come off strong and create friction.

I use various methods to clear negative energy that builds up over time on my deck, and that includes first clearing myself of any negative vibes. If I am not in a good space energetically speaking while cleaning my deck, it's like mopping the floor while wearing big old pair of muddy boots! The shower (aka my portal to the beyond) is a great place to let bad vibes go down the drain. I imagine the water as pure light energy washing away all the murky mucky muck that tends to build up over time. Another technique and not to go too far down the woo-woo hole here is to imagine that holding all that negative junk in your body is one of those rubber tub stoppers with a metal chain. Imagine it is near your belly button or Solar Plexus. Now envision giving the metal

chain a good tug until the rubber stopper comes out, and with it, you release all the emotional toxins that seep into our bodies as a result of just well living.

The sun, when present (I am in Seattle, so it's often hit or miss nine-months out of the year), is also an excellent resource for clearing away any negative energy. The power of its light is transformative, and it doesn't take long, nor does it require you to get naked (unless you are into that, and that is awesome too—you and Ben Franklin, in that case, have something in common.)

I find just ten to fifteen minutes sitting comfortably in the sun does a wonderful job of shifting my mood.

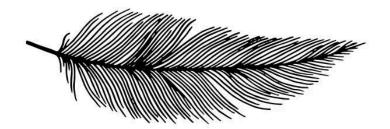
Cleaning the house and saging are two activities that, for me, go hand and hand. Not only do these activities make our home pleasant to be in, but it also raises the overall vibration. Saging I have found has a calming quality for both my child and pup Layla, so overall, it's a big win!

To clear a new deck or to clean a deck that has some negative energy build-up, I start by washing the cards. First, you spread the cards all over a table (image side down) and swish them around. Make sure they are nicely mixed up. Then let your intuition guide you around the table, picking up a card from one area then a couple from another. When you have about a third of the cards in your hand, shuffle them until you feel ready to stop and then

put that stack aside. Go back to the table and pick up some more cards from various places until you have only a third remaining. Shuffle the cards and set them next to the first stack. Finally, gather the remaining cards and shuffle those as well. Stack the piles however you like and then shuffle the deck as a whole. If it is a full moon, that evening set the deck near a window that allows the moonlight to come in.

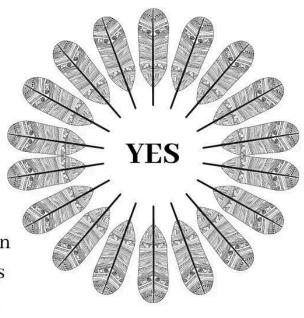
You may also want to keep your deck protected by using crystals such as clear quartz in your deck bag on the box.

Before you touch the deck of cards to do a reading, clear your mind. The goal is to transition into a space of feeling at peace and connected to divine energy. I find floral scents such as jasmine and rose help me escape from day to day stress and create a feeling of inner calm. You may find going for a walk is your path to your higher-self. Sometimes turning up the music and dancing can do wonders for disconnecting from stress. However, it is that you get to a place of peace; it is in the end up to you.



Single Card: Yes/No/Maybe

To use the Crow Tarot as an oracle simply think of a yes or no question. Shuffle the deck then randomly pull a card. Use the chart to discover what your crows advise.

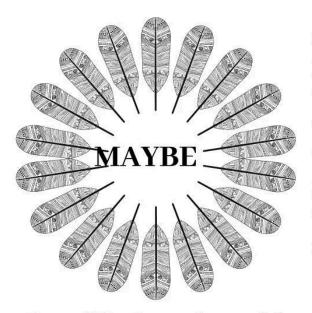

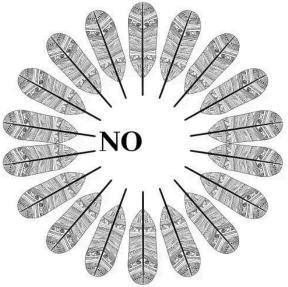

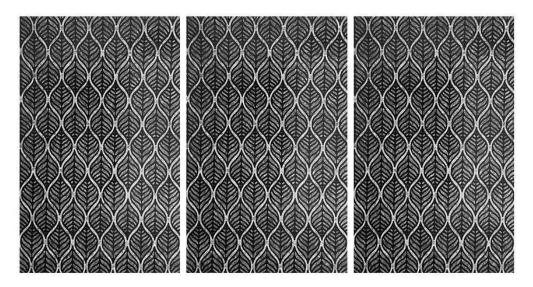
Single Card: Advice

Single card draws can be especially useful for finding problem areas or knots that keep your energy from flowing smoothly.

Quiet your mind and hold the deck in your hands firmly. You may have a specific question in mind, or you may want to see what information your guides or higher-self wish to convey to you at the moment. Shuffle the deck until you feel that little tug in your gut—pull a card. Sometimes the message may be so obvious it is like a crow smacked you upside your head; other times, the message may be more subtle. Sometimes the message is undeniable, yet we choose not to see or understand because of denial.

I find it very interesting when the same card appears several times in a month. When this occurs, I see it as a message that my guides are trying to get my attention, and clearly, I must be either ignoring them or too daft to understand the first two or three times. You will find a place in the back of this book to chart your daily draws for a month. What cards do you find repeat over and OVER?

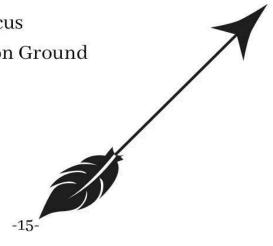

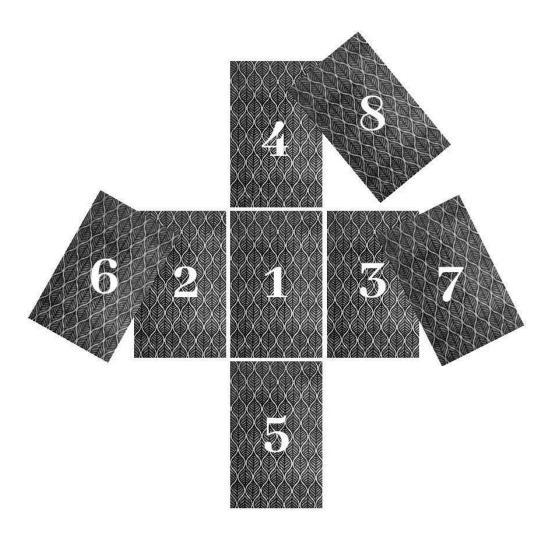

Eight Card Crow Spread



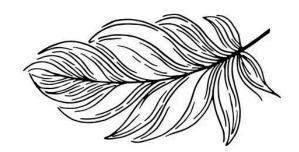
1. The first card represents your heart, and the honest emotions that you feel—the desire that you hold within. It is here that you send energy out that is pure of—well heart. This is your beacon, your light that transmits messages to the Universe. When you are operating at a high frequency, this card will tend to be positive and represents a goal that is in alignment. A negative card may indicate that your mood or frequency is low, and as a result, your actions and intentions may be out of alignment.

- 2. To the left of the heart is the energy you attract as a result of the messages you are sending out into the Universe. Can you find a connection between the first and second cards of the reading?
- 3. You may feel in your heart a strong desire for a positive outcome, and your frequency may be as high as it can be; however, in this position, the card reveals how your subconscious mind can sabotage success. Check out the negative attributes for this card, do you recognize any of these traits or habits?
- 4. The area of hopes and fears connects to the third card or subconscious card in this reading. What is driving you? What do you hope, or what are you afraid of that is the source of friction?
- 5.Your grounding energy. You will find your strength here, that part of yourself that keeps you connected to the earth. For example, if the card you draw is the Ten of Cups, you may find your source of strength comes from being part of a loving family. If the Tower or the Death card appears in this area of the Crow Spread, your strength may be that you are adaptable and can let go and face change courageously.
- 6. The past often repeats itself, and in this position. The card reveals a lesson from your history that may be relevant and holds wisdom for your current situation.

7. Think of this card as the uninvited house guest. This external influence will enter your life with little help from your actions as they are operating from a space of free will. This person may end up providing the answers or help you need, or they may end up mucking something up. You can't control what they do; you can only control how you react.

8. The crows travel through the veil and bring back what they see as the best approach to ensure that your outcome is the most beneficial.

I like to expand this reading by running through each position three times. The first card layer gives a base understanding of the energy that is present, and the following layers provide more insight. I have found that to do a full Crow Spread with three layers plan on at least 30 minutes; however, at least for me (I am a bit chatty), they tend to run closer to 60 minutes.





Symbolism

Although I took artistic license, you will find in the Crow Tarot many of the same symbols as in the Rider-Waite-Smith deck. When I created the Crow Tarot, I felt it was essential to work within the parameters of tradition concerning symbolism as I was using the creative process also to teach myself the Tarot.

You will find color plays an important role in the Crow Tarot as it sets the stage or mood for the energy represented on the card.

Red

You will find the color red throughout the Crow Tarot. From the infinity symbol to the poppies, I chose this color because it symbolizes strength and passion as well as danger, conflict, and power.

Pink / Magenta

The color pink represents calm, warmth, love, acceptance, and the feeling of security. You will find various shades of this color throughout this deck from lotus flowers to the warm sky of the Seven of Pentacles.

Orange

The color of the bright, warm sun—orange demands attention! It represents an energy that is flamboyant and enthusiastic. This color can also represent health, change, and balance. Although mostly positive, you will find this color represents decay due to neglect in the form of rust on the Ten of Swords.

Yellow / Gold

Although yellow has many meanings, including cowardice, I chose to use the color to represent happiness and joy in the Crow Tarot. The color of fresh spring flowers and summer days, shades of yellow help conjure up an energy that supports comfort and bliss.

Green / Patina Green

You will find various shades of green throughout the Crow Tarot. Aside from being my favorite color, green represents completion and abundance. It is the signal to "go" and is often associated with good luck. What's not to love about the color green? Of course, it can also represent greed and envy; however, in the Crow Tarot, green was mostly used to signify personal development and growth.

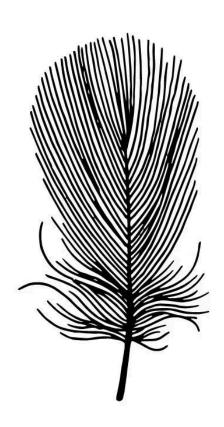
Blue

The color blue can represent a sharp mind with a clear vision, aloofness, or coolness, for example, the Queen and King of Swords.

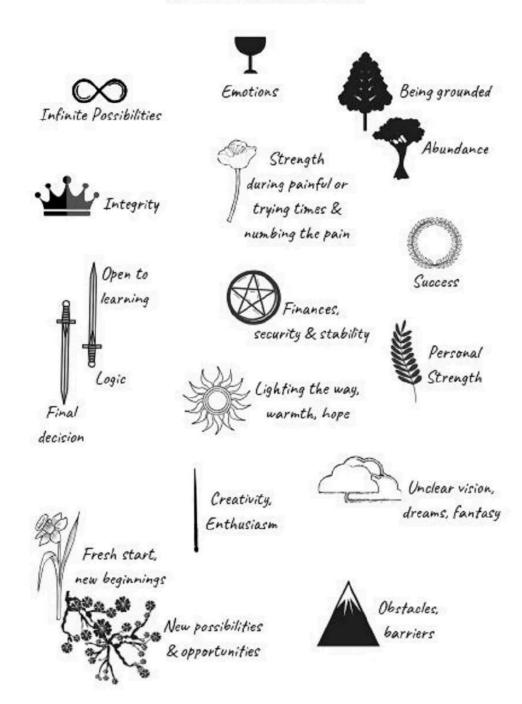
Blue also represents loyalty, status (blue blood), and dependability. For the Nine of Swords, the color blue is associated with depression and over-analyzing a situation.

Purple

Purple evokes mystery and magical forces—it is a color that represents the subconscious mind and creativity. For centuries purple has also been associated with royalty and nobility. In the Crow Tarot, the color purple appears in the form of feathers that decorate the King of Swords' throne as well as the swirl around the High Priestess's eye.







The Major Arcana





The twenty-two trump cards of the Major Arcana represent the various archetypal energies that reside within each of us. It is this underlying and influential energy that often goes unacknowledged. Yet, at the same time, it performs an essential role in how we respond to situations as we travel along the journey of life.

We begin our trip through the Tarot, as the Fool, childlike, free, and full of optimism. To the Fool, the world offers boundless opportunities that feed our desire for spontaneity, entertainment, and adventure. For the Fool.

it is not about the final destination; instead, the purpose of the journey lies in the experiences and possibilities for gratification. When we encounter the Magician, that is when we take control, no longer content with going with the flow, we accept accountability for the outcome.

It is through the Magician that we learn how to pull together resources that will create an aspired transformation. It is here that we recognize our power and the magic we hold within.

The High Priestess moves between the material and spiritual realms. When she appears, she comes as an advisor and serves as a connection to our higher self or subconscious mind. It is the voice of the High Priestess that signals when and when not to act.

The Empress enters at a time when our journey would benefit from the nurturing and abundant energy of a mother. To ensure that advancement continues and our trip proceeds with integrity and a clear vision, the Emperor arrives as a respected leader.

The energy of the Emperor complements the loving, motherly Empress, and the Emperor serves as a traditional father-figure who restores order during times of chaos and creates the feeling of security.

When our tour reaches the Hierophant, that is when we seek to understand our cultural heritage; it is in our search for belonging when we find the wise soul who serves as a teacher and spiritual advisor.

As we mature and our individual beliefs develop, we reach the Lovers who propose an opportunity for two opposing forces to come together to establish a karmic bond.

It is when our values become part of our identity that we sense the fearless and charging energy of the Chariot. During this leg of the journey, we discover the advantage of control and discipline as we learn how to direct our impulses and emotions with precision.

The Chariot delivers us to Strength. Understanding our motivations and feelings, Strength teaches us how to apply this knowledge when working with others who may bring conflict. Strength shows us the power of patience and of developing a soft touch to reach the desired outcome. It is at this point in our journey through life that we learn about grace and our inner strength.

When we enter the deep dark woods, that is, when we encounter the Hermit, we go inward and experience introspection. This is when we meet a mentor and a guiding light. It is the wisdom we attain during this time that will someday light the way for others.

The Wheel of Fortune marks the halfway point of the Fool's journey, and it is here that we begin to understand our destiny, our place in this world, and the power of good luck. The Wheel of Fortune also serves as a reminder that the course is not direct; instead, it twists and turns to offer moments that are smooth and easy, and at other points, it is steep and riddled with impediments. In time, we will inescapably encounter both.

With growth and wisdom comes a greater awareness of our responsibility as Justice brings to our journey a willingness to hold ourselves accountable for our deeds.

Despite the knowledge gained and the strength achieved, we encounter forces that are beyond our control and hold us back. When progress stalls at the hands of another, it is because we have met the Hanged Man.

Although stagnation can be frustrating, it is the Hanged Man who pushes us to see our situation from a new perspective and thus sparks growth.

The time comes to confront the inevitable when Death appears along the trail; we must accept the demise of something so that we can continue progressing, as fate is not done with us just yet.

It is not long after we encounter Death that Temperance emerges, bringing moderation and an urge to find balance as a means of relieving or soothing a problematic or painful ending.

Every journey that grants an opportunity for growth and learning includes interaction with the Devil. It is the energy of the Devil that teaches us that not all beasts appear as they are: some arrive in masks. It is the Devil that causes us to feel comfortable to the point of laziness and removes pain until we become numb to all the sensations of life. It is the Devil that will have us placing ourselves in bondage. However, his many, many faults the Devil does at times add value to a situation as he creates passion and fuels desire.

The Tower follows the Devil on our mission, and its purpose is to generate havoc. The disturbance caused by the Tower is one that we can't ignore, as it uproots us and causes distress that rattles the bones. It is the Tower that shows us what we are made of. Can you rebuild?

When the dust settles, it is the divine light of the Star that elevates us up and out of the rubble. The Star bears the gifts of inspiration and the promise of a better tomorrow. When our trip seems to be going smoothly, and we see the sky as cloudless, that is when our journey takes us to the Moon.

The light of the Moon reflects our anxieties and illusions; it reveals the shadow self that we try to suppress. The Moon encourages us to remove the mask that conceals our inner nature, and not only confront our true self, but also to allow our shadow moments some freedom.

We awake to a rising Sun that revitalizes the soul with its radiating warmth and comforting glow. It is in the brilliant light of the Sun that we dare to stand center stage, allowing ourselves to be seen.

As the journey enters its final leg, we must face Judgment. It is during this encounter that we are called to reflect upon our lives, to honor our history as a whole story, a complete account compiled of the good, the bad, and yes, the times we wish we could do-over. Combining our experiences create a comprehensive picture of who we are, not solely as a human being, but as a spiritual being. To advance, we must accept ourselves as a whole and take responsibility for who we have become.

Our trip concludes with the World, and much like the end

of a delicious several course meal, the feeling we experience at this point in our journey is one of being utterly satiated. For now, life is pleasant, and there is a feeling of ease in the air. Rest up as you bask in this moment of success because with every ending, there will be a beginning.





The fledgling hopped along the edge of the riverbank, where it spotted a log floating along in the water. General Message

The Fool speaks of innocence and possessing a child-like spirit. The message this card offers is one of letting go of expectations and the need to judge or over-analyze a situation with a critical eye or our jaded adult-eye. The Fool asks that you be open to new experiences and resist the need to control a situation. When the Fool is present, have faith that the Universe will offer an adventure worth pursuing.



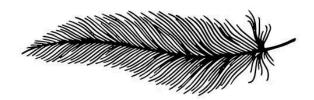
The Log: Buoyancy, unsinkable, optimism

The Wind: Warning, other people's fears or concerns

Trees: Feeling grounded, balanced root chakra, an opportunity for abundance

Lotus Flowers: Pure heart, divine intervention

Fern Leaf: Inner-strength



Positive Traits / In Balance

Trusting, having faith in the unknown, living in the moment, being spontaneous

Negative Traits / Out of Balance

Reckless, acting without considering others, wasting time on frivolous pursuits

The Fool may represent a time spent following a pipe dream or putting your faith in something or someone without considering the consequences. The Fool may also serve as the foundation for a divinely guided situation.

Is your current situation one that benefited from a leap of blind faith, or do you look back to see only time spent goofing off?

Present Position

In the Present position, with the energy of the Fool swirling around, you may feel more inclined to agree to a blind date, a last-minute road trip, or apply for a job that you would have once considered a long shot.

Could your current situation benefit from having faith? Are you able to let go of the need to take control and enjoy the journey of life?

Advice Position

The Fool advises you to take chances and allow for inspiration to be your guide. Although the Fool asks that you have faith in the process, in this position, it cautions against being complacent.

Are you going with the flow, or are you avoiding responsibilities?



The crow extended its massive black wings as it gracefully lifted into the air. The bird lifted its head and took a deep breath and summoned the creative energy that circulated through its veins. Feeling energized, the crow then stretched its neck and tilted its beak, just so, and with a flash, the crow connected with the transformative electricity that thundered above in the clouds. 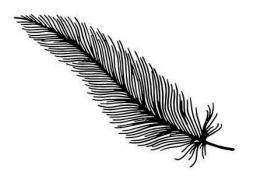

General Message

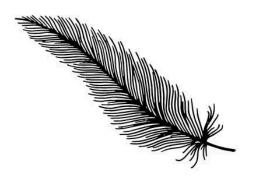

General Message

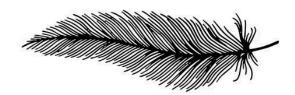

General Message

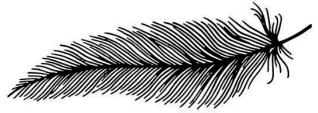

General Message

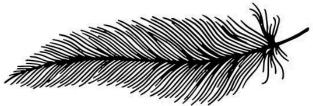

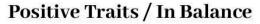
General Message

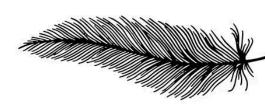

General Message

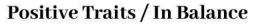

Along the journey, he lost a few feathers, but it was a small price to pay for a chance at something more significant—a cause that sat firmly within its heart. The rumbling of the sky echoed through its hollow bones as bolts of lightning shot violently out of the clouds, but the young bird would not be deterred. If anything, the electricity in the air fueled the bird's enthusiasm as it took on the storm as if it was a worthy challenger.



General Message

The Page of Swords has the heart of an activist as passion, conviction, and a quest for truth collide. When you speak from your center, to convey a transparent and honest position, you will find others who unite behind your cause. General Message

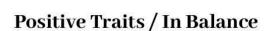

General Message

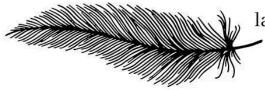

Manifesting and Spellcasting

Every Law of Attraction guru will tell you the key to manifesting is feeling with complete conviction in your heart that your desire isn't just possible that it's also already out there—waiting for you to reach out and grab it. You can wish day and night for a new car, new job, a boatload of cash, or a new hot romantic partner, but unless you actually believe profoundly without question that your desire exists and you are worthy of obtaining it—you might as well save your energy. And right there, there is the kicker because all too often even if we don't admit it, there is some little part of ourselves buried deep down that believes that we don't deserve whatever it is that we want.

Simply wishing, birthday wishes, wishing on a star, making a wish you see 1111 or whatever sign you connect the Universe to is like calling in a pizza order without actually dialing the number. You aren't going to get pizza, and all it does is remind you of how much you want it when it doesn't show up in 30 minutes or less.

Tarot cards come in quite handy when you need to reinforce a positive belief or solidify an intention because they allow suspension of disbelief. Your logical mind won't be fooled into thinking your desire is real without proof, and when you stack the cards in your favor, you trick your rational mind into accepting the reality. That is all very crow-like if you ask me. That being said, you must believe with your heart of hearts that the cards are bringing forward to you something real, something tangible otherwise, we just fall back to square one.

First, things first. What is it you want to manifest? Is it at all realistic? Could you obtain this thing without the help of the all-powerful Universe? Sure, you can try and manifest a rocket to the moon, but really, I mean—really? You would need some serious suspension of disbelief to pull that off or a connection at NASA. However, a new job, a partner who treats you like a god or goddess, a little extra spending money, all those things are available to you right now with or without the help of the Universe. Getting the Universe involved is just to make the process a bit easier. It's like having an extra set of hands when you need to do some heavy lifting. Sure, you could figure out how to get a couch down three flights of stairs alone, but it is a hell of a lot easier when you've got help.

First things first, imagine what your life will be like after you achieve this goal. How do you feel? Are you wearing new clothes? Did you move to a new home? Are you free of the stress that comes from feeling worried about money? Let it all linger around your brain. Also, have

fun with this as you get to create what you want, why limit yourself?

Before you get out the Tarot cards, take some time to write a little thank you note to the universe that outlines how your life has improved as a result of the manifestation.

I have a "Universe" box that I created years ago. It's basically just a fancy box with a slit on top for depositing letters. I do not open it, it is only for one way communication with the Universe. Or if you have a fireplace, I find it sometimes more satisfying to burn the letter. Watching my words turn into a bright blaze then poof off it goes. Either way, I figure my message is being sent, and really that is all that matters here.

Now that we are mentally prepped and ready to go, it is time to get to work! Yep work, I didn't say it was easy, and the Universe isn't running some sort of charity. It does, however, happily, eagerly, actively provide for those who take action, of course, the definition of action may vary depending on what you are trying to achieve. Are you asking the Universe to metaphorically speaking here, move a couch, or an entire house? Like a friend, the Universe isn't going to happy about moving your belongings while you sit on the couch, snacking on chips.

Next, pull out twenty-four of the most positive cards that relate to your desire. For financial matters, you may want to pull out the Magician, Strength, the Wheel of Fortune, the Sun, Six of Wands, King of Wands, Ace of Swords, Ace of Pentacles, Seven of Pentacles, Ten of Pentacles, Page of Pentacles, Queen of Pentacles, King of Pentacles...you get the picture.

Hold the cards in your hands and focus your question around what it is you would like to manifest. I suggest keeping the question positive. For example, ask if your new job will have opportunities for travel and a bigger salary as opposed to asking whether or not you will get a new job. See the difference?

Shuffle the cards and then create a Crow Spread (pg 16)

Because you shuffled the cards and there are more cards than spots, there is a sense of chance, and in that—right there in that randomness, you find the magic. Sure, you could have pulled out the positive cards and placed them where you wanted them, but that doesn't work because it leaves too much room for the rational mind to make excuses for why it isn't possible. It is in not knowing where each card is going to land that gets our creative mind going.

To manifest a new loving relationship, you may want to

pull out cards such as the Empress, the Lovers, the Star, the Sun, Ace of Cups, Two of Cups, Nine of Cups, Ten of Cups, Knight of Cups, Four of Wands, etc.

Let the position for each card sink in.

What card landed in the inner self or heart position? Can you feel the energy that card holds deep in your soul?

Direct your attention now to the second position. Can you find examples of that card's energy swirling around you?

The third position is the energy that our subconscious mind conjures up. Although this could reveal blocks in spellcasting, it here to reinforce a positive belief and offer supportive energy.

Similar to the third card, the fourth card in the hopes and fears position may reveal to you a hidden fear around your desire that could sabotage your spell. Acknowledge it and focus your attention on resolving the belief so that you can move on.

The card in the grounding position will prove especially powerful as it will help reinforce your feelings towards your desired outcome. It will be what keeps you motivated.

The lesson in the past will help you realize that your dream is not so out of reach. Think about a time when you achieved a similar goal.

It is in the external influences position that you encounter the butterflies in the belly that comes from meeting someone or finding an opportunity that will help you reach your goal.

The last card is the advice/outlook card. Looking pretty good right?

The last step is to look at the spread as a whole and believe it to be true! Hold the feeling in your heart and see it in your mind's eye. What action can you take to get the ball rolling?

You may also want to summon up so serious enthusiasm as well as that will send a message out saying, yes you are ready, yes you believe this desire of yours is there waiting for you, and yes you will take the opportunities that will help you achieve that goal. Come to think about it, you might want to have the Page of Wands handy as well.

When it comes to manifesting, it is best to start small and think of each attempt as an experiment. The goal is to reinforce the notion that you have the power to attract, and belief is essential.
